## Select Committee Reviewing Standing Orders

1. This Select Committee was appointed by Resolution of the National Assembly dater poth September 1973 "to review the Standing Orders".

3. Up to the date of this Report there have been Eleven Meetings of the Comitiee.
*. The Committee has received, in ardition to suggestions from its own Members, written representations from the Hon. Chief Kitonga, M.P., ant the Hon. A. Araru, M.F., for which the committee is grateful.
4. The amendments of standing Orfers which the Committee recomends are set out in the First Scherule hereto.
5. During the course af its deliberations, the Comittee inevitably touched upon mattexs relating to the powers, privileges and immunities of the House. Although not required to do so by its terms of reference, the Comittee respectfully recommends that a Select Committee be appointed in due course to probe and report on the vast and vexed question of parliamentary privilege.
6. Finally, to facilitate effective implementation of these recommendations, especially with regara to the committee system, and to ensure that the Legislature plays its full part in the ramified process of regulating the affairs of a modern State, it is necessary that the Clerk's Department be reorganized and its establishment expanded. The Comittee particularly notes with concern the difficulty encounte... $i n$ attracting qualified and retaining experiencer senior staff, owing to inadequate xecognition of their status consequent upon general ignorance and apathy about the requirements of a Farliamentary institution.

The Comittee therefore recommends that appropriate action be taken forthwith to improve the terms of service and emoluments attaching to the posts of Assistant Clerks, particular regard being had to the specialized nature of their work and the fact that the body which they sexve is the supreme legislative borly in the Nation and the ultimate repository of the sovereign power which exists in all systems of government.

(vi) Committee on Agriculture, Lands and Settlement.
(vii) Committee on Finance, Commerce and Industry, and co-operatives.
(viii) Committee on Works, Fower and Comimunications.
(ix) Committee on Defence and Foreign Relations.
(x) Committee on Natural Resources (including Forests, Mineral Resources, Wildlifo and Fisheries).
(3) It shall be the duty of the committees referred to in the preceding paragraph to investigate and enquire into the activities and administration of such Ministries or Departments as they may consider necessary and such investigation and enguiry may extend to proposals for legislation.
