2020/2021 VALUES AND PRINCIPLES COMPLIANCE EVALUATION ANNUAL REPORT

Article 234 (2)(h) of the Constitution, Section 16 of Public Service (values and principles) Act 2015 and Section 63 of the PSC Act 2017 requires the Public Service Commission as a responsible Commission to evaluate and report to the President and Parliament on the extent to which the values and principles mentioned in Articles 10 and 232 are complied with in the public service. Since 2012 the Commission has undertaken evaluation on Compliance with the public service values and principles and submitted nine reports containing crosscutting and institution-specific recommendations for action by public organizations.

Towards this end, the Commission will use an online survey tool during 2020/2021 evaluation cycle due to its robustness in facilitating data collection from the institutions and data analysis, and to mitigate the Covid-19 challenges. We have organized **Webex webinar platform** demonstration sessions on the use of the tool by institutions from **23rd to 26th August 2021** as provided for each sector in the program below:
