SESSIONAL PAPER NO. 17 OF 1975 - ACP/EEC LOME -

The Lome Convention was signed in Lome, Togo on 28th February, 1975 between African, Caribbean and Pacific islands (ACP) countries and the European Economic Community States (EEC).

The objective of this Convention is to promote trade among the Contracting Parties and also to cooperate in industrial, financial and technical fields.

The Minister for Commerce and Industry, Hon. Dr. J.G. Kiano, M.P., was in Lome for the occasion and signed the Convention on behalf of the President of the Republic of Kenya.
