PUBLIC SERVICE INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME (PSIP): DECLARATION OF INTERNSHIP VACANCIES IN MDAs FOR 2021/2022 FINANCIAL YEAR

The Public Service Commission, as part of its mandate and responsibility for empowering the youth, has been integral in ensuring that they have access to internship opportunities in the Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs).

Institutionalization of the Public Service Internship Programme (PSIP) commenced with the development of the *Internship Policy and Guidelines for the Public Service* in 2016. Later on in the Financial Year 2019/2020, the Commission initiated a centralized recruitment process, where successful applicants were deployed and assigned mentors and guided to gain direct practical work experience within the public sector institutions. In addition, the interns have had the opportunity to develop additional skills, expand their viewpoints and discover new networks and career aspirations. So far, about Six Thousand (6,000) youth have benefited from the programme, while another Three Thousand (3,000) interns under Cohort 3 are currently in session until February, 2022.

In the current Financial Year 2021/2022, the Commission will recruit another cohort of interns to take up the slots arising from expiry of the internship contracts, as well as additional internship opportunities that would be declared by the MDAs. Consequently, the Commission invites all MDAs to submit details of available vacancies on the format below:
