1.0 INTRODUCTION

This section gives the background information on the socio-economic conditions that has a bearing on the development of the county.

1.1 COUNTY BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Uasin Gishu County has its headquarters in Eldoret Town and covers a total area of 3,345.2 Km². It extends between longitudes 34⁰ 50' and 35⁰ 37' East and 0⁰ 03' South and 0⁰ 55' North. The county is on a highland plateau with altitudes falling gently from 2,700m above sea level at Timboroa in the East to about 1,500m above sea level at Kipkaren in the West.

Administratively, the county is divided into six sub-counties namely Ainabkoi, Moiben, Soy, Turbo, Kesses and Kapsaret which are further sub-divided into thirty wards. The population for the county was 894,179 in 2009 according to the 2009 Population and Housing Census and is projected to increase to 1,123,165 and 1,211,853 in 2015 and 2017 respectively at an intercensual population growth rate of 3.8 per cent.

1.2 SECTOR PRIORITIES

The County Government is on year three of County Integrated Development Plan (CIDP) implementation which aims at attaining 5 goals: household food security; reduce poverty and increase incomes; improve literacy levels; enhance the healthy status of the citizens; and improve infrastructure in the County. The CIDP further outlines 36 objectives drawn from across the sectors of the county economy which inform sector priorities and strategies. Therefore, the priorities outlined in the CIDP and the five pillars mentioned in the CFSP 2015 will continue to guide the development agenda of the county in the coming financial year 2016/17.

1.3 RECENT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Recent economic development at the global and national scene has a direct bearing on the economy of the county. Rising overall prices of commodities; increasing interest rates and a weaker shilling will negatively affect the county's economy largely driven by agriculture, real estate and inflows from sports, especially athletics. However, given her strong growth potential, the county will build and leverage on its strategic economic, geographical and social positioning, to shed off any effects from such shocks.

1.4 FY2014/15 BUDGET IMPLEMENTATION

The County Government implemented a Kshs 6.929 B budget (Recurrent 3,415,799,492 and Development 3,513,649,306) in the 2014/2015 FY. During the period under review, various programmes and projects were implemented and are at different levels of implementation as indicated in 2014/15 FY Budget Implementation Report.
